

Rocklin High School FHA-HERO Accepts \$5,000 Check



Teens in the Driver Seat (TDS) has received a \$5,000 grant from State Farm Insurance. The funds provided are from State Farm's Good Neighbor Citizenship grant program and will help TDS, a program of the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI), expand its presence in California with programming at schools, like Rocklin High School. With an emphasis on all major traffic safety risks for teens, TDS empowers teens to shape and implement the peer-to-peer program. TDS is available to high schools in California at no cost. The Rocklin FHA-HERO team, shown in the picture, is the newest TDS program school and used the event to kick off activities. The check presentation was on Monday, November 18, 2013 at 1:15pm at Rocklin High School. Those in attendance included Rocklin High School FHA-HERO members and teacher, State Farm regional staff and local agents, and Teens in the Driver Seat staff.
