## MAKE -UP BAG INSTRUCTION SHEET

### SUPPLIES NEEDED:

11" x 18" Fabric

Pattern

Tape Measure

Zipper (put your name on it)

Small Paper Bag

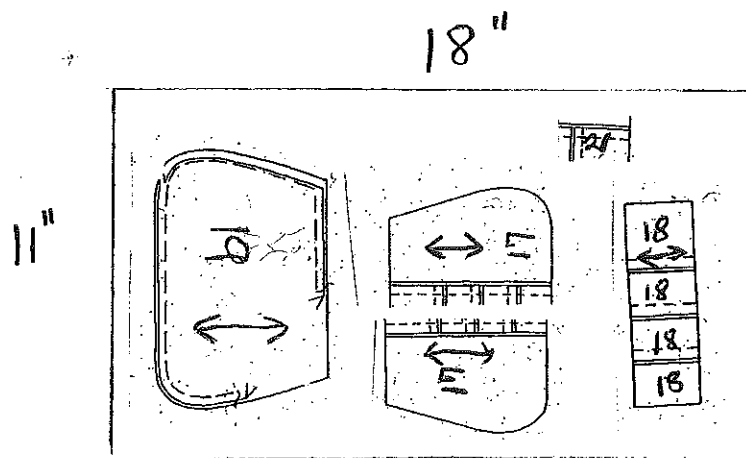
Pins

Shears

1. Select a partner for cutting. Be prepared to partner with another pair for fabric exchange.
2. Put your name and class period in the center of each pattern piece.
3. Separate the pattern pieces by cutting them apart. Leave piece #18 together. We will cut these apart later. DO NOT CUT ON THE BLACK LINE.

### PATTERN LAYOUT

4. Place two different pieces of fabric RST matching fabric edges. \_\_\_\_ tp\*
5. Lay pattern pieces on fabric according to the following layout. See class sample and demonstration about grain.

## Makeup bag instructions

### CUT THE FOLLOWING :

Cut 1 piece 19 (back)

Cut 2 piece 17(front)

Cut 4 piece 18(squares)

Cut 2 piece 21(zipper tab)

Cut one strap 3inches by 9inches

Cut 2 piece 19 (lining)

Select zipper

6. Pin pattern pieces onto fabric according to sample. Make sure you measure your GRAINLINE. \_\_\_\_\_tp\*
6. DO NOT CUT UNTIL IT HAS BEEN APPROVED FOR CUTTING. Cut pattern pieces out using sharp shears. DO NOT REMOVE PINS.
7. Mark DARTS. See class demonstration. \_\_\_\_\_tp\*
8. Cut piece #18 apart so that there is 4-squares.
9. EXCHANGE FABRIC WITH ANOTHER PAIR OF STUDENTS.

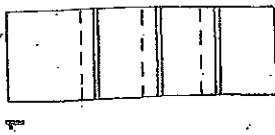
1-#19 BACK  
2-#17 FRONT  
4-#18 SQUARES  
2-#21 ZIPPER TAB  
1-7" Zipper

TO BE CUT:  
2-#19 LINING  
1-STRAP 3"x9" optional

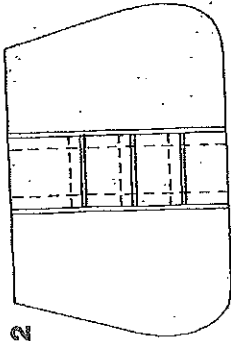
Place all fabric pieces in a bag with your name on it.

# MAKE-UP CASE D

**NOTE:** *Stitch using 3/8" (1cm) seams unless otherwise indicated.*

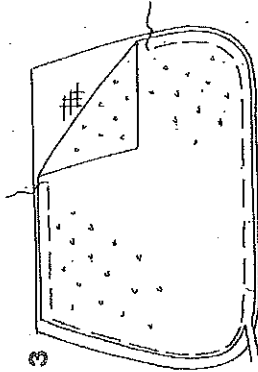

1. With **RIGHT** sides together stitch front patch together, as shown. Press seams in one direction.

2. With **RIGHT** sides together, stitch front to side edge of patch strip. Press seam allowances toward front.

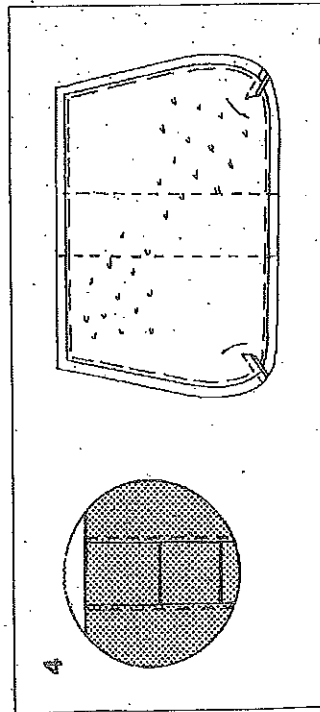

3. Apply fusible interfacing to **WRONG** side of front, following manufacturer's directions.

Pin padding over interfacing, having raw edges even. Machine-baste raw edges together.

To reduce bulk, trim away padding close to basting.

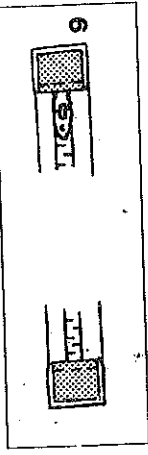
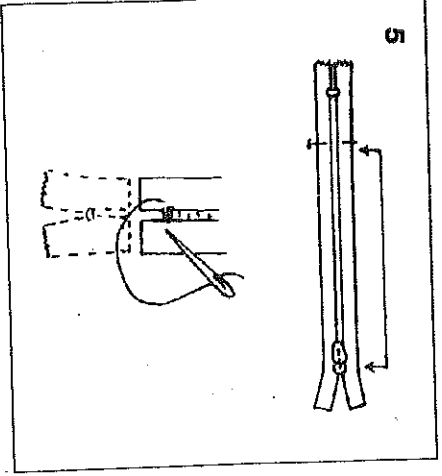
4. On **OUTSIDE**, top-stitch front along seams.

Make darts on each front.

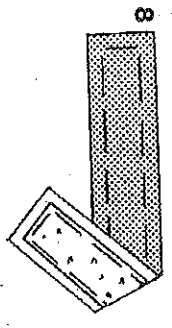
To reduce bulk, trim dart seam allowances close to stitching. Press dart to one side.

**Prepare back same as front, disregarding patchwork.**

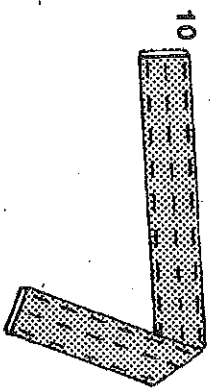
5. It will be necessary to shorten the zipper as follows:  
Close zipper and measure from the tab down along the teeth 6" (15cm). With matching buttonhole twist or heavy duty thread, make several overcast stitches across zipper teeth. Trim away lower end of zipper tape to within 3/8" (1cm) of overcast stitches.



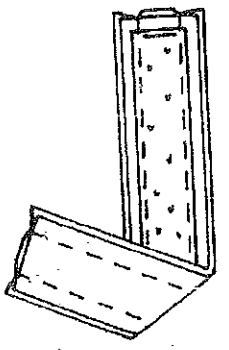
6. Fold zipper end along fold line with WRONG sides together; press. Pin to zipper, as shown. Stitch close to fold.
7. Press under 3/8" (1cm) on upper edges of front and back. With zipper face up; pin pressed edges of front and back a scant 1/4" (6mm) from zipper teeth, having raw edges even. Using an adjustable zipper foot, stitch front and back close to pressed edges.



8. Pin padding to WRONG side of strap, having raw edges even. Machine-baste raw edges. To reduce bulk, trim away padding close to basting.



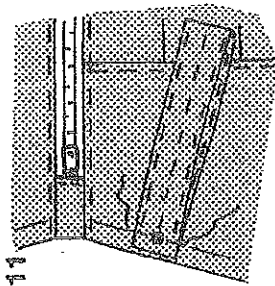
9. With RIGHT sides together, pin strap to lining, having raw edges even. Stitch long edges. Trim seams.
10. Turn strap; press. On OUTSIDE, top-stitch 1/8" (3mm) from long edges and along center of strap.



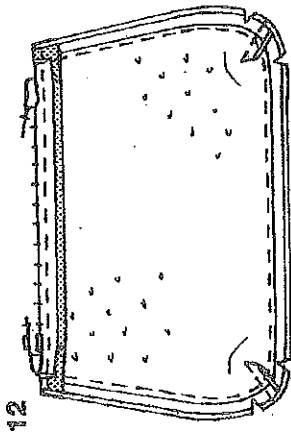

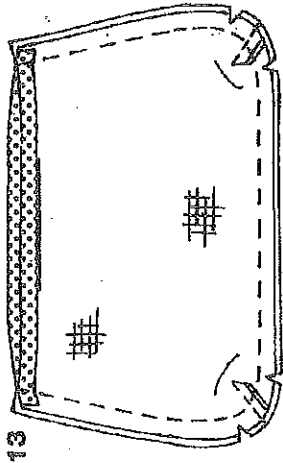

11. Fold strap in half, having raw edges even. Baste across ends. On **OUTSIDE**, pin strap to bag, as shown, centering over large dot, having raw edges even. Baste.

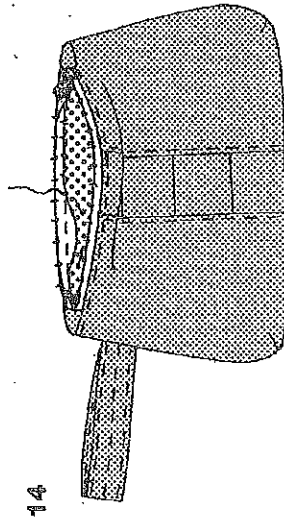


12. Open zipper. Fold bag in half, with **RIGHT** sides together, matching dart seams and having raw edges even. Stitch sides and lower edges. Trim seam; clip curves. Turn bag; press.

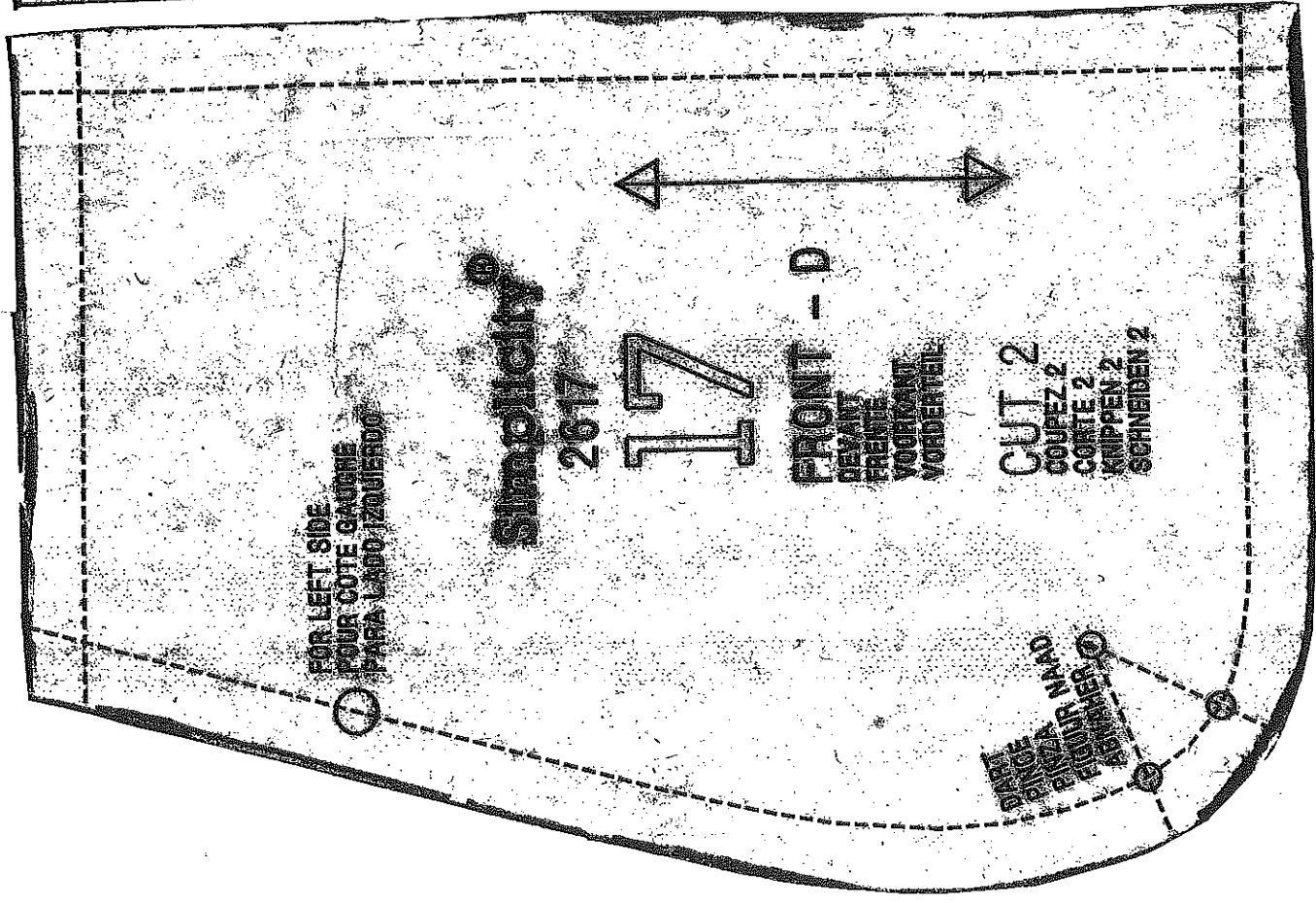
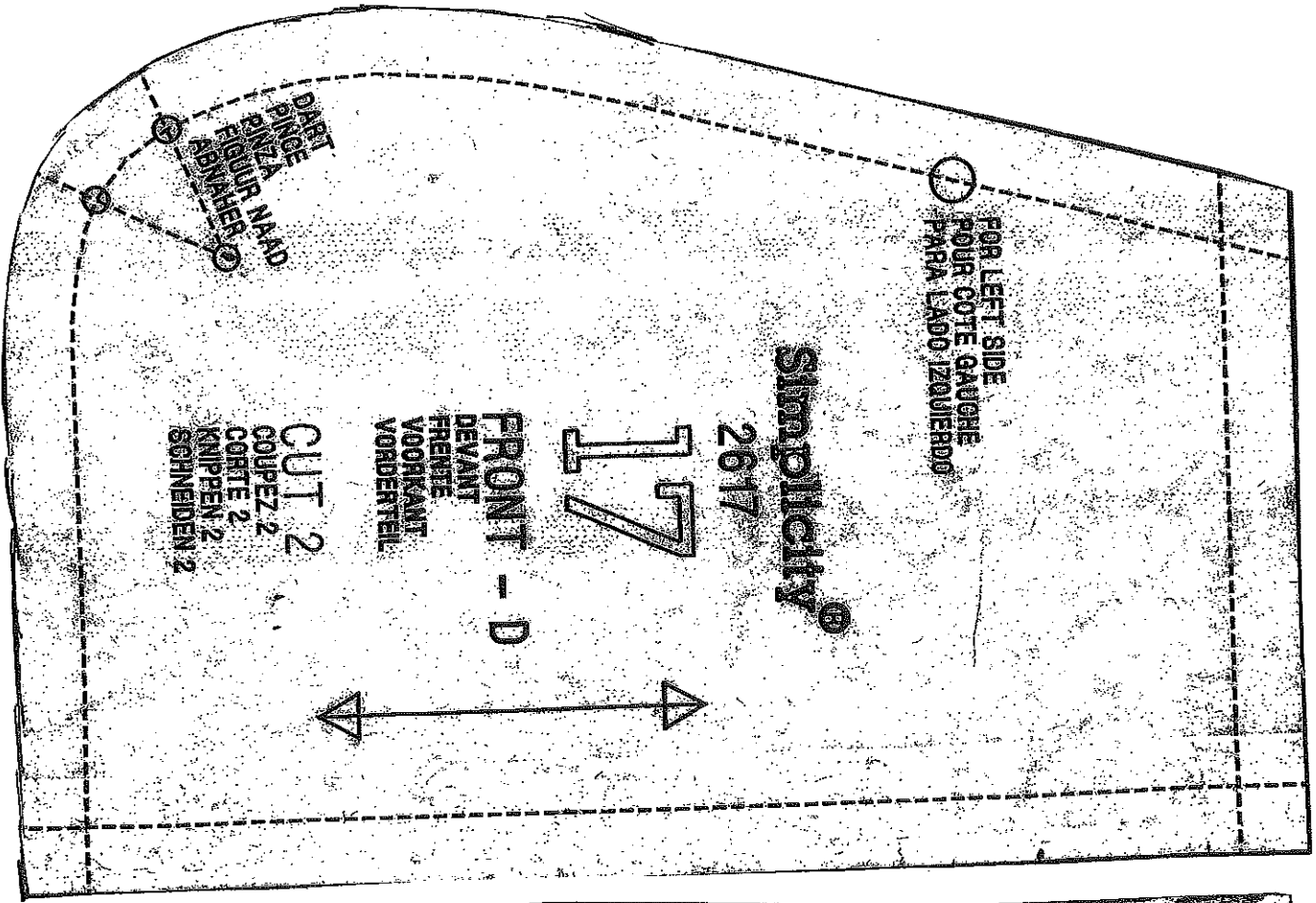


13. Apply fusible interfacing to **WRONG** side of lining sections, following manufacturers directions. Make darts at lower edges.

Press under 3/8" (1cm) on upper edges of lining. With **RIGHT** sides together, stitch lining sections together, matching dart seams and having pressed edges even. Trim seam; clip curves.



14. With **WRONG** sides together, slip lining into bag, matching seams. Slip-stitch pressed edges of lining along zipper tapes and along zipper ends.
