




Proposition 28: Arts Education Funding

- Will be housed in CCTD
- Development in early stages
- \$941 million, estimated

Governor Newsom's Proposed Budget

 No proposed reductions to any CTE funding source





Golden State Pathway Programs

- Funding: \$500,000.000
- Up to 85% (\$425,000) College and Career Pathway Development
- Up to 10% (\$50,000,000)
 Consortium Development
- Up to 5% (\$25,000,000)
 Regional Technical Assistance
 Centers
- Seven year grant life through 2028-29
- Competitive grant program



Golden State Pathway Programs

- To promote pathways in technology, health care, education, including early education and child development, and climate-related fields.
- Encourage collaboration between LEA, institutions of higher education, local and regional employers.
- Enable pupils to access postsecondary education/workforce opportunities
- Development of a skilled and educated workforce, with an emphasis on positions in childcare settings, preschools, prekindergarten, kindergarten, or any of grades 1 to 12.
