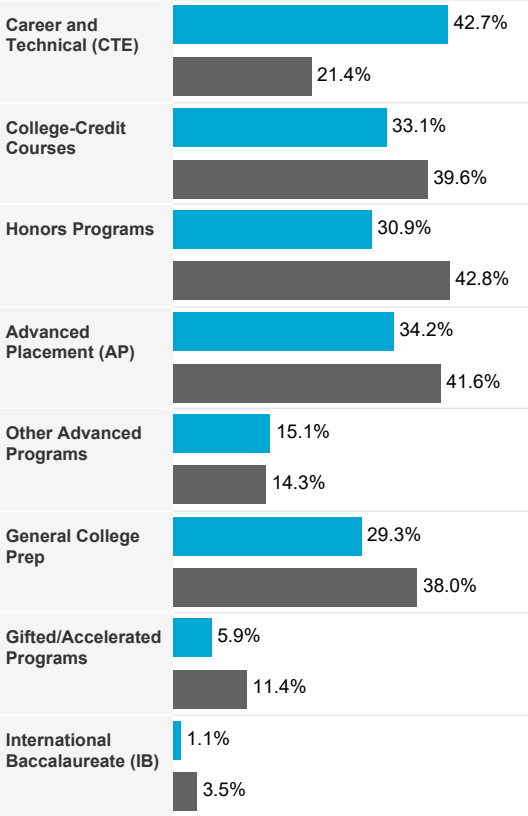

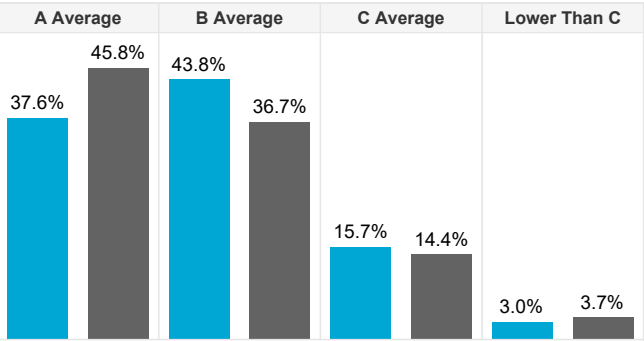

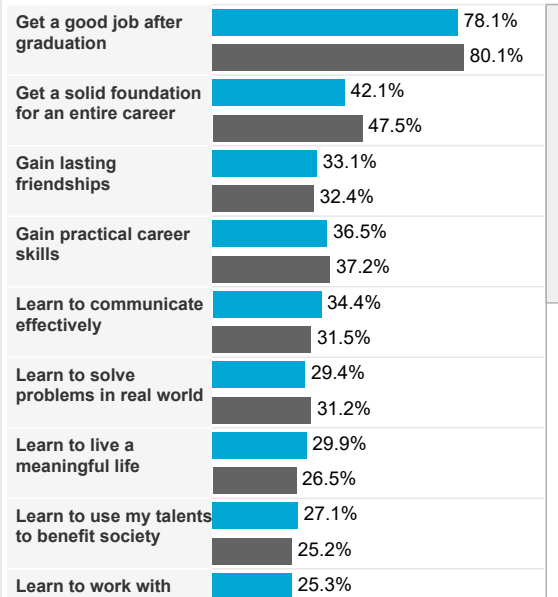

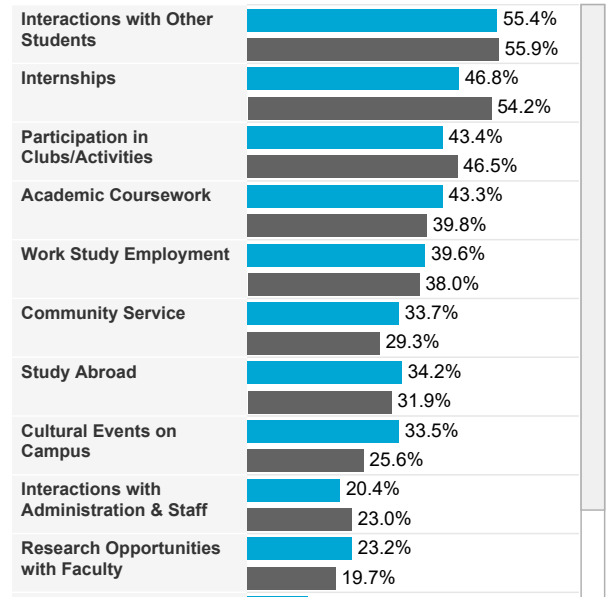

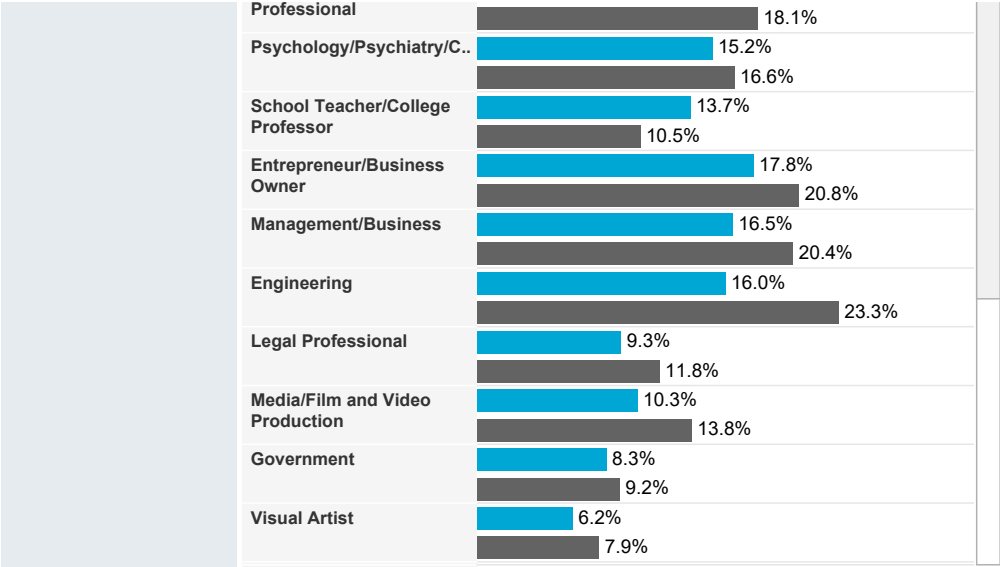

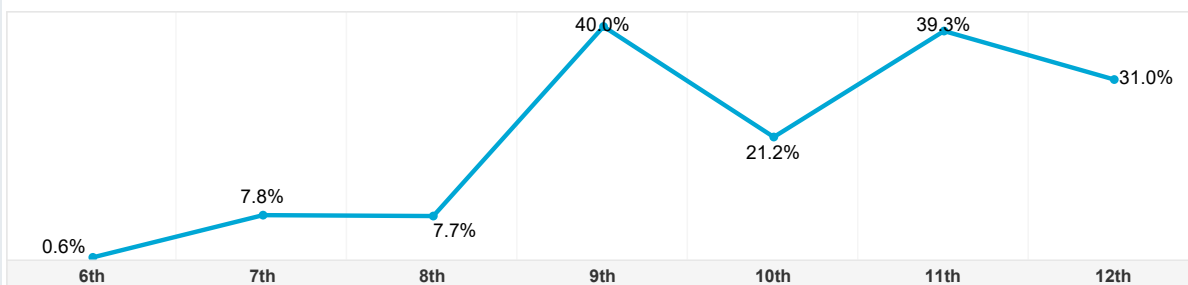

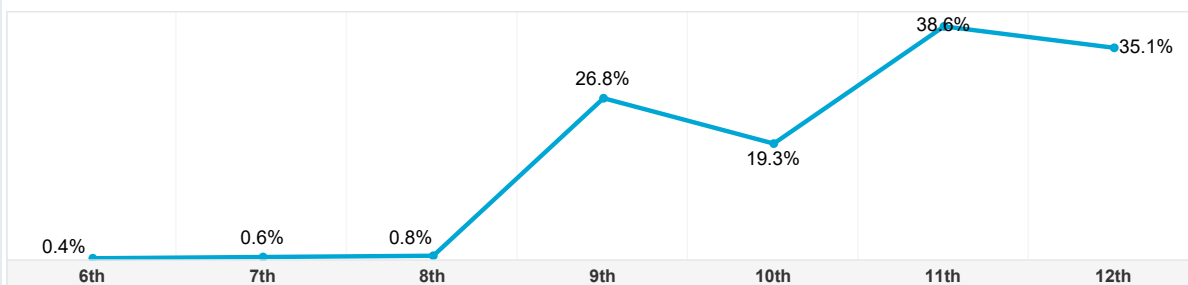

FCS Coursework by Grade



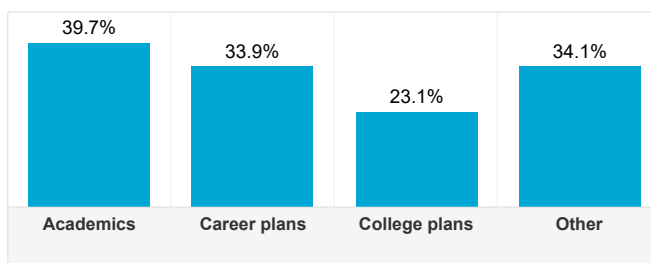

Skills Gained in FCS Classes

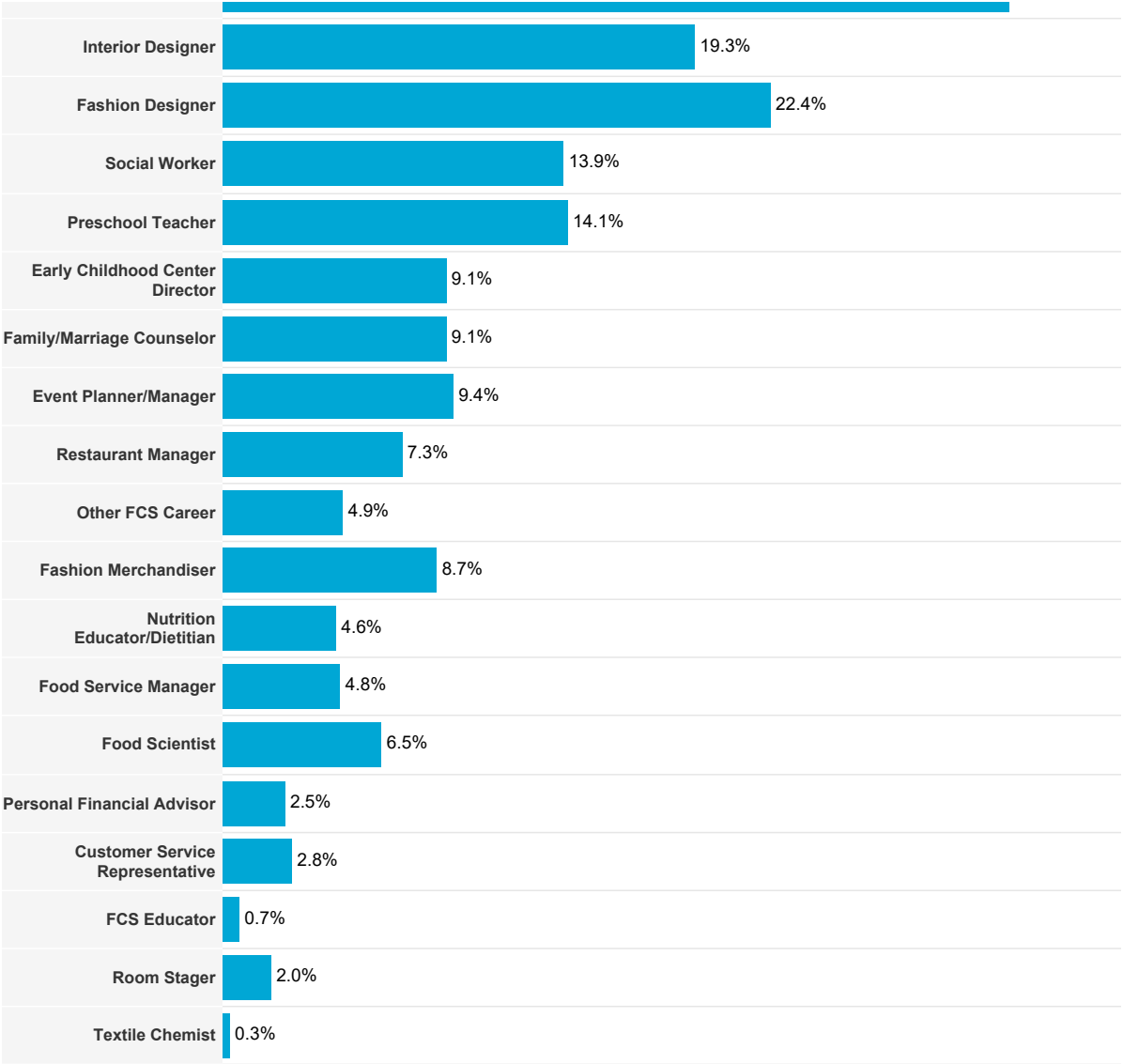


Areas of Positive Impact from FCS Classes

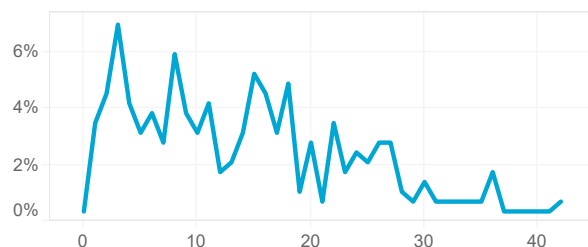

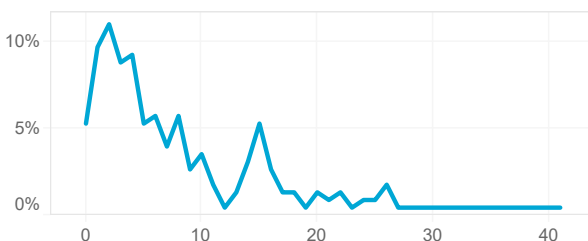

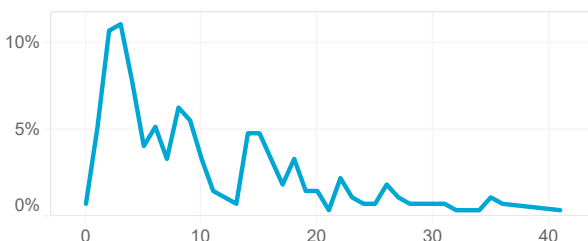
Teaching Tenure



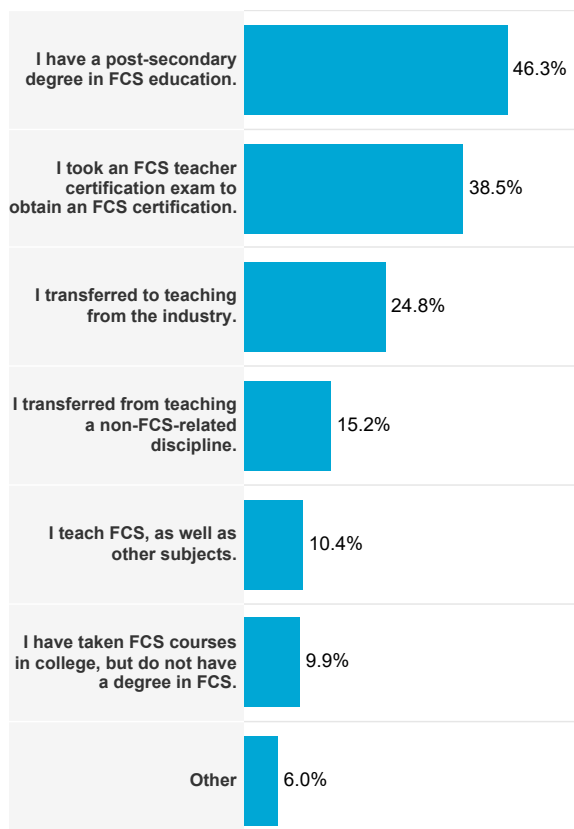
FCS Teaching Tenure

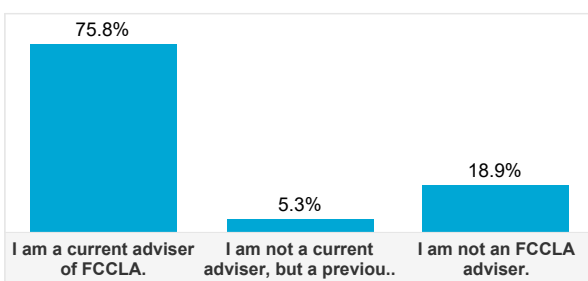

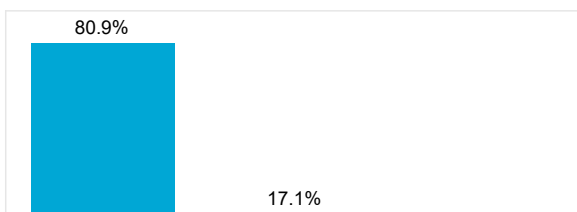

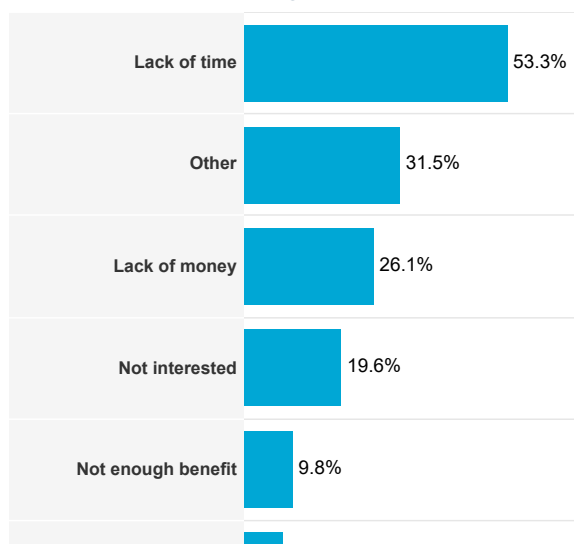

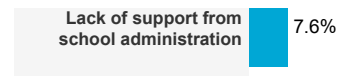


FCCLA Chapter Status



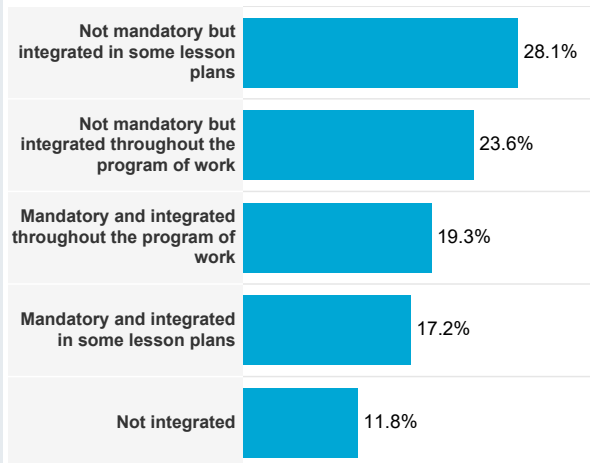
Reasons for Not Advising FCCLA



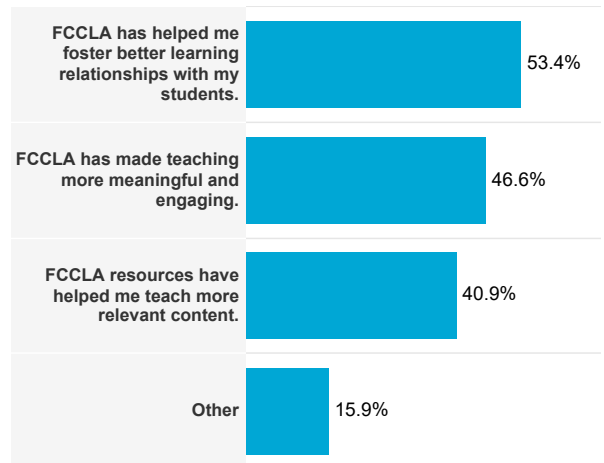

Integration of FCCLA in FCS Curriculum

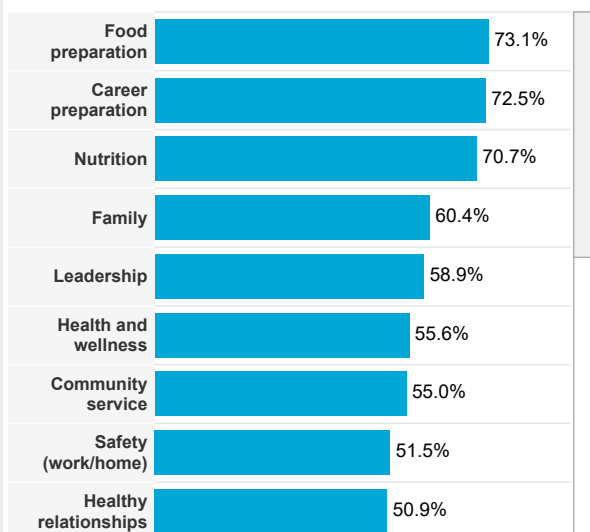


Impact of FCCLA on Teaching

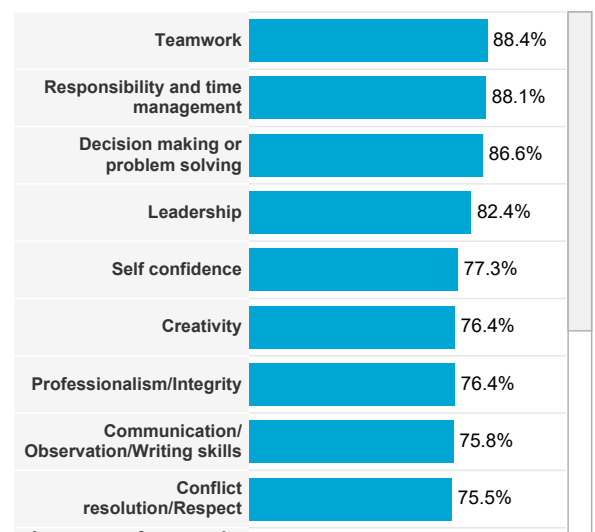


Topics Covered in FCS Class

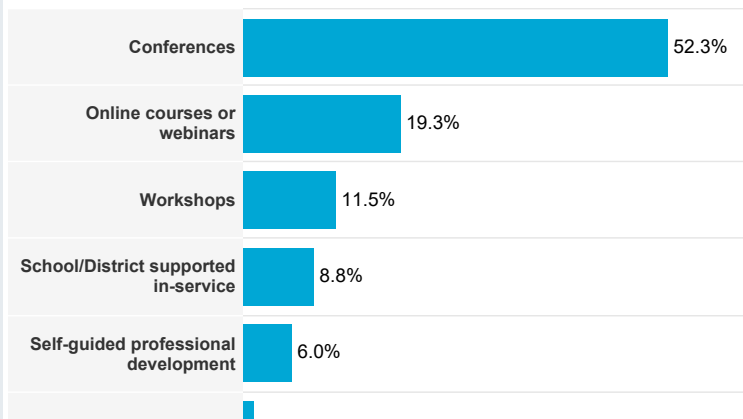


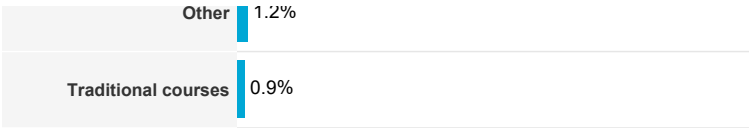

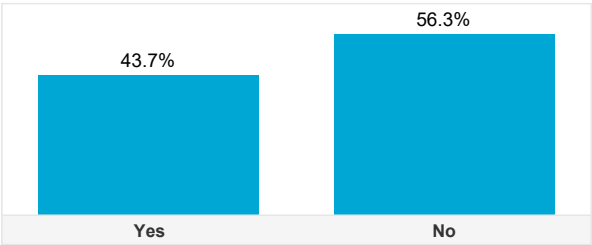
Preferred Method of Professional Development



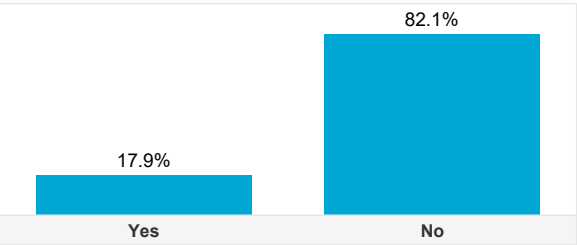

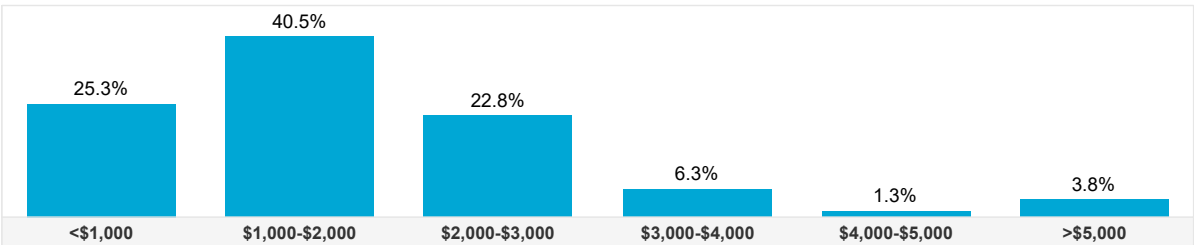
Receive Stipend/Compensation



Stipend Provided Through Grant

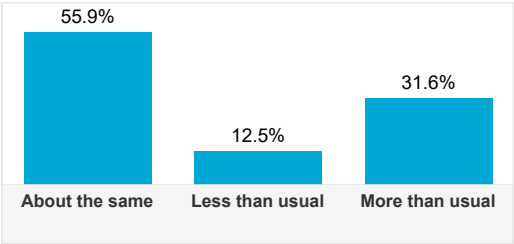


Stipend/Compensation Amount

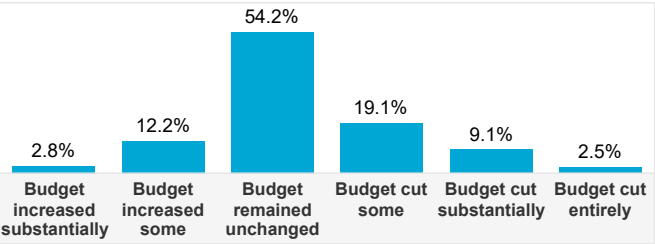


Changes Since Pandemic

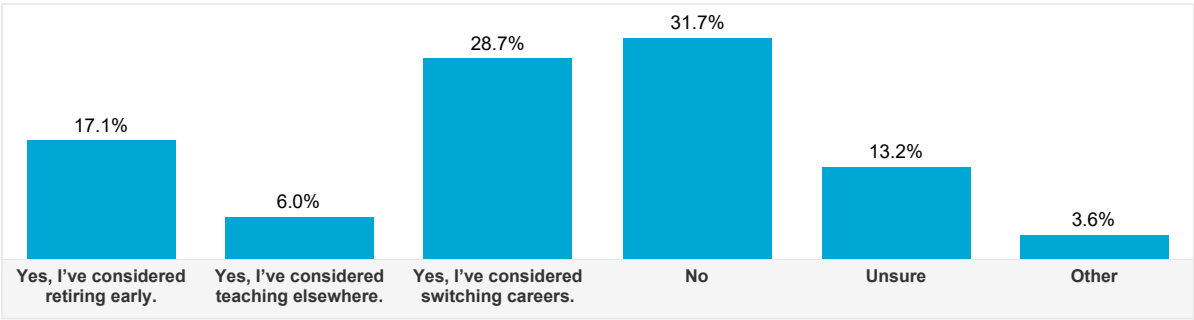
Change in Support Since Pandemic

About the Research

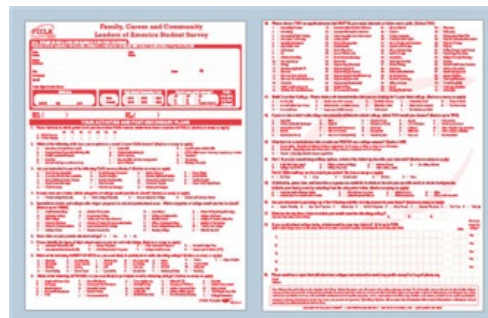
The research displayed in these dashboards was created through a joint effort between myOptions® and FCCLA to examine the state of foreign language education in our nation's high schools.
