


SAFETY SURVEY FOR A HOME



BATHROOM: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nonskid mat or strips on both tub and shower floors • Handrail or bars in tub • Medicines and cosmetics in child-proof containers and safely stored • Doors that unlock from the outside • • • • 	BEDROOMS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smoke detector nearby and working • Light switch, lamp, or flashlight located near bedside door • Crib that meets legal safety standards • Toys put away at night • Plastic bags over clothes out of children's reach • Chain or rope ladder available for emergency escape from second story • • • 	
KITCHEN: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All appliances and electrical cords in safe condition • Small appliances disconnected • Knives and scissors safely stored • Pan handles turned away from range front • Grease, water, and food spills wiped up • Sturdy step stool handy • Fire extinguisher handy • • 	LIVING ROOM OR FAMILY ROOM: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Furniture arranged for free movement • Carpets and rugs with nonskid backing • TV and stereo sets placed so that air can circulate around them • Electrical circuits not overloaded • Unused outlets plugged with child-proof covers • Extension cords in good condition and not under rugs • • • 	
LAUNDRY AREA: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appliances clean and in safe condition; lint traps clean • Soaps, detergents, and bleaches safely stored • • • • 	FLOORS, HALLWAYS, AND STAIRS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No loose rugs or broken steps • Hand rails on stairways • Well lit; night-light installed • No tripping hazards on steps • • • 	GARAGE OR BASEMENT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paint, pesticides, and car-care products safely stored • Oily rags stored in covered metal containers • Old newspapers recycled • • • •
