What is Edpuzzle?

- EDpuzzle is a teaching tool used to place interactive content into pre-existing videos from a variety of sources, such as TED or YouTube, or into videos you have made.
- Syncs with google classroom
- Features include trimming videos, adding voice-overs, embedding notes and questions into video
- Free account to teachers (limited amount of videos can be saved), subscription for unlimited available for purchase



- Show a video synchronously in class
- · Assign a video for asynchronous work
- Measure comprehension of topic
- Integrate critical thinking questions
- Use for assessments/quizzes
- Use for lectures (can record voiceover)
- Trim long segments into smaller ones




Benefits and Challenges of Edpuzzle


Benefits:


- Search for existing

 national geographic, etc. and
 edit questions to fit your needs
- Can view students' progress as they watch and answer ?s
- Multiple choice questions are graded by computer
- A lot of students know how to use it already!

Challenges:

- Takes some time to
 Upload and edit your own
 videos from your computer
 or drive (though it is possible)
- Takes some time to review existing videos and edit questions
- Open-ended questions take some time to grade
- Some videos blocked by filters

If you want to edit the video questions or length click "edit". If you are ready to assign it to your students click "assign". To delete it from your content, click "delete".






























This is what the questions look like to students







Assign to students via google classroom. Choose a start date and due date.


Teachers can turn off skipping capabilities here. They can also turn on closed captioning.
