
# Credentialing Questions

- Single Subject Home Economics Credential  
You are qualified to teach all Consumer Family Studies (CFS) and Home Economics/Family and Consumer Sciences Related Occupation Courses.

If you are teaching an occupational course then your district may require you to update your industry experience through professional development. There are no set number of hours that you must complete. That number is completely up to your school district.

- Academic Reinforcement
  - Cross-discipline integration and collaboration
  - Common Core reinforcement
- 317 HECT UC a-g Approved Courses at 214 High Schools (7.5% increase)
- Sept. 15, 2016 final submission deadline
- Re-opens February 1, 2017





- **Focus is to promote financial literacy**







# Leadership Packets

- Purchase of leadership packets may be made using Perkins funds, SB-1070 funds, and district instructional supply budgets
- FCCLA leadership, career, and citizenship knowledge and skills are required curriculum components of Perkins
- 2016-17 SB-1070 Funds Allocations to 44 chapters totaling \$80,000




**FCCLA PSA: Help us Speak UP!**
